

NAMIBIA 2002 SKELETON COAST AND THE KAOKOLAND

The Route

- Day One.24/11 Heathrow to Windhoek where your Vehicles will be waiting. Shopping and fuel before travelling onto Spitzkoppe where we will have our first camp.
- Day Two.25/11 Late start, leave for Rhino camp @ 9:00. Fuel at Uis mine. In the evening half of the group will be able to go on a Rhino walk while the rest of the group bush drive looking for Rhino.
- Day Three.26/11 Rhino walk or drive for the early morning before travelling on a sand track through a dry river bed to Aba Huab.
- Day Four.27/11 Leave Aba Huab and onto visit the Rock Engravings at Twyfontein, then onto Palmweg for a game trek.
- Day Five.28/11 Palmweg To Opuwo via Safontein to re-supply and pick up guide for Himba villages.
- Day Six.29/11 Visit the Himba villages and wild camping near Orupembe.
- Day Seven.30/11 Orupembe to Opuwo via Etanga where we will reprovision, before wild camping some kilometres outside the town.
- Day Eight.1/12 Epupa Falls.
- Day Nine.2/12 Rest Day at Epupa falls.
- Day Ten.3/12 Bush roads to a camp at Ruacana Falls.
- Day Eleven.4/12 Ruacana to Tsinitzabis (Bushman camp) at Omuraba on the Ovambo river. Today the roads are tarmac for most of the way.
- Day Twelve.5/12 Omuraba to Waterberg Plateau Park on the edge of the Kalahari. This park has an incredible variety of bird life
- Day Thirteen.6/12 Arnhem Caves and rest camp.
- Day Fourteen.7/12 Rest day near Windhoek at an hotel. Hire cars will be returned
- Day Fifteen.8/12 Fly home.
